

Magnetized Advent Calendar

The perfect quick project for your advent calendar needs, this calendar is a fun addition to your advent celebration.

Supplies:

Fabric scraps
Rubber number stamps
Archival ink
Mod Podge (decoupage glue)
Aleene's Tacky Glue
Cookie sheet (try not to get the non-stick kind like I did! LOL!!)

Let's sew it all together...

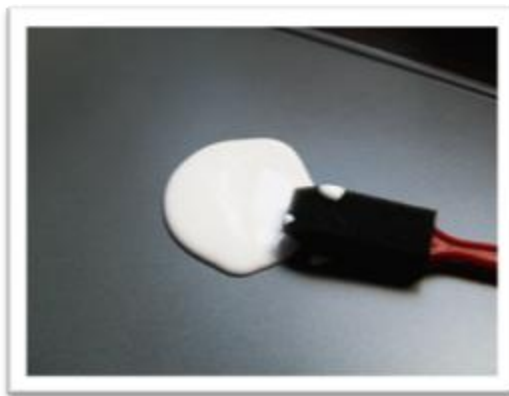
Sew 5 rows of 5 2.5" squares all together.
Stamp the numbers 1-25 on each square.
Sew 1" strips all around the grid.
Sew 2.5" strips on the top and the bottom of the piece.
Sew 2" strips on the top and bottom of the piece again.
Sew 1" strips on the sides of the piece.

HINT: once you have the grid sewn and stamped, you can sew random scraps of strips around to fit the cookie sheet. Don't be beholden to the measurements! Be a little spontaneous!! Yay!!

Get your glue on...



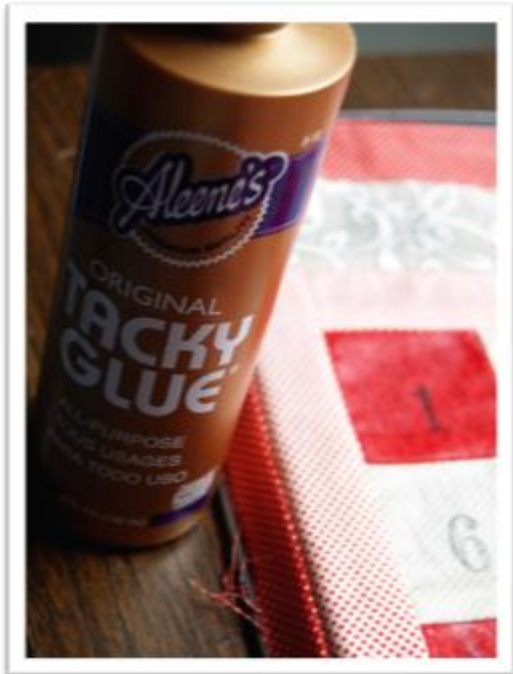
Get your Mod Podge out and a sponge and get ready to glue your fabric to the cookie sheet.



Pour glue on the back of the cookie sheet and cover it!



Place your fabric on it and then pour glue on top of your fabric and spread it all over. Let it dry!



Get your tacky glue and your rick rack ready to go...



Run a small strip of glue around the edge of the cookie sheet and place your rick rack on top of the glue, holding it down as you do each side and each corner.



To punch a hole in the top of the cookie sheet, you can use a Crop-a-dile to punch through the metal!
Yay!

Punch a hole on two sides of the top and then draw a ribbon through to make the hanger!



And here is your project!!



Use a strong magnet to mark the days leading up to Christmas! Yay!!
