

The Star Crossed Block

Cutting:

Blue Cottage Fabric

1 strip - 3" x WOF (2" strip)

Subcut into 4 - 3" squares (2" squares)

and 8 - 2.5" squares (1.5" squares)

White Background Fabric
1 strip - 3" x WOF (2" strip)
Subcut into 4 - 3" squares (2" squares)
9 - 2.5" squares (1.5" squares)



Sewing:


1. Mark a diagonal line on the 4 - 3" background squares.



2. Take your marked squares and place them together with the blue fabric and sew a 1/4" seam on either side of the line you've drawn. Cut your blocks on the line.



3. Trim your blocks down to 2.5" (1.5")




4. Lay out your blocks in rows as pictured:



5. Sew your block together in rows.



6. Sew your rows together nesting the seams together.



Yay! For the bed runner, make 5 star crossed blocks.
